In coordination with the Centre for South Asian Studies, University of Edinburgh (<http://www.csas.ed.ac.uk/>) the Britain Nepal Academic Council announces its seventh Nepal Study Day to be held on 30th March 2009, at the University of Edinburgh. This year the study day has been timetabled to coincide with the British Association of South Asian Studies (BASAS) conference also to be held at Edinburgh. At this increasingly popular event BNAC encourages presentations, sharing and discussion of research and work ongoing in, and on, Nepal (see [http://digitalhimalaya.com/bnac/study\\_days.html](http://digitalhimalaya.com/bnac/study_days.html) for previous days and examples of work presented). Research from all disciplines will be considered, and this includes work here in the UK and elsewhere in relation to the Nepalese Diaspora. We particularly encourage presentations on as yet unpublished ongoing research, and work from doctoral students.

If you are interested in presenting please send a brief abstract of 250 words to Dr Ian Harper ([ian.harper@ed.ac.uk](mailto:ian.harper@ed.ac.uk)) by 10th February 2009. In keeping with previous study days, papers of accepted abstracts will not be circulated in advance, but presented on the day. There will be no conference fees, but a small stipend will be collected towards the payment of refreshments. Small bursaries towards travel will be paid for those postgraduates whose presentations are accepted.
